

Confirming its positive trend, The London Textile Fair, has become an unmissable event for all industry professionals.


EXHIBITORS PROFILE

TLTF is the leading UK trade show for European based textiles and accessories manufacturers, which have together more than 90% of the total exhibiting space. The rebooking rate is around 95% and, with the Business Design Centre at full capacity, we have a long waiting list of companies waiting to get in.



Within the Textile Hall, exhibitors will present an extensive selection of wovens, woollens jersey, jacquards, menswear, womenswear, kids wear, brides and occasions fabrics, silks and synthetics. Due to their increasing popularity, the July edition will have a wider selection of organic, denim, technical, active wear and sports wear fabrics.

TLTF is predominantly European; the most represented Countries are Italy (28%), Turkey (23%), UK (19%), Portugal (9%) and Spain (6%).
