

VISITORS PROFILE


We forecast about 5500 – 6000 visitors for the January edition, 90% of which from the UK. TLTF is the leading textile show in the UK with a consistent and increasing number of industry professionals coming from Central and North Europe.

EXHIBITORS PROFILE

The accessories and textiles halls have together more than 90% of the total exhibiting space, with about 400 exhibitors. The rebooking rate is around 95% and, with the Business Design Centre at full capacity, we have hired 2 new rooms to accommodate 50 new exhibitors.



January's 2017 edition will have a wide selection of womenswear, menswear, childrenswear fabrics and accessories with an increasing number of technical textiles manufactures.

The Accessories Hall has grown exponentially over the last 4 editions, showcasing an impressively diverse range of products from the best European manufacturers.

The Print Design and Vintage Garments hall attracts the leading UK and international studios, with a large number of studios exhibiting also at The London Print Design Fair which takes place in March and October.
