As the registrations come through, we expect more than 5000 visitors in two days. With an average of 85% of visitors from the UK, TLTF has an increasing number of people coming from France, Belgium, Italy, Portugal, Northern Europe and Middle East.



EXHIBITORS PROFILE...

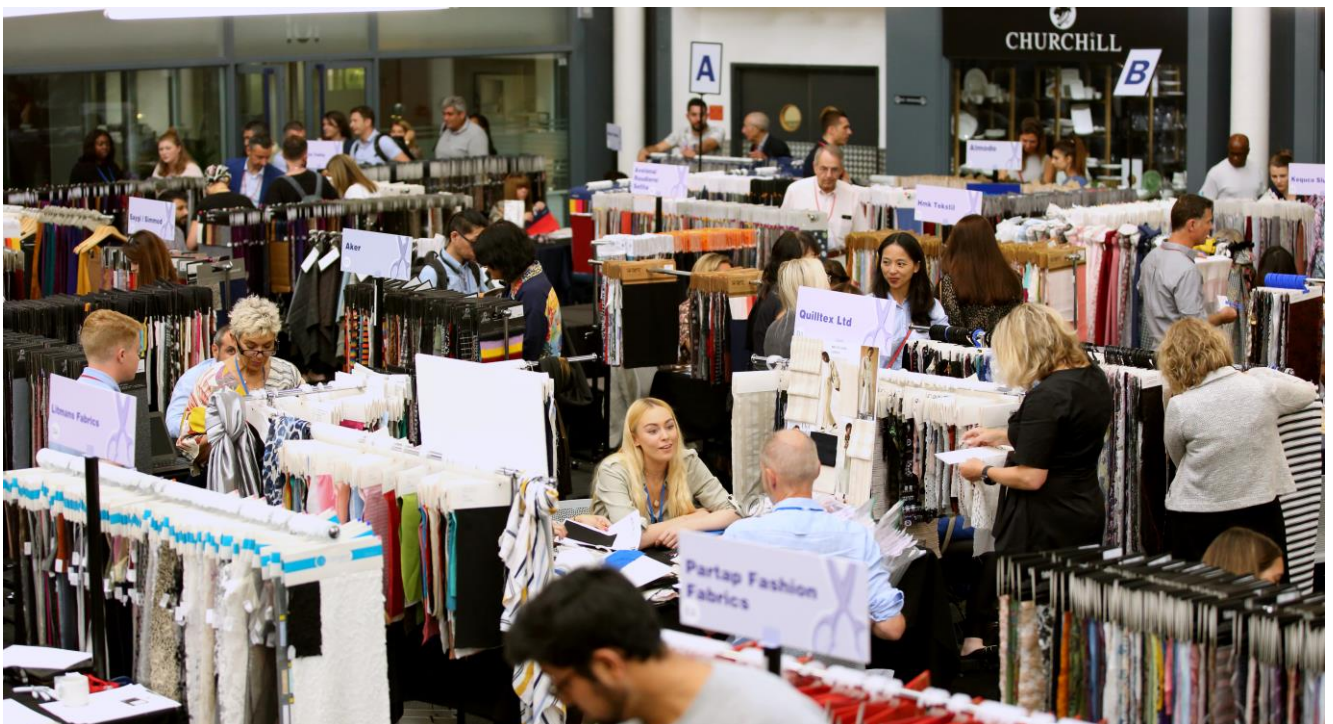
Fashion Fabrics (Village Green, Mezzanine and Auditorium) is the predominant area of the show, counting 400 exhibitors presenting over 600 collections. Mainly European, with exhibitors coming from Italy, France, Turkey, Portugal, Spain, UK and more.

The Accessories area, in the Gallery Hall, offers a wide selection of buttons, labels, zips, tapes, linings and trimmings from the top European manufacturers. The hall will host 60 exhibitors from Italy, France, UK, Spain, Germany, Denmark, Portugal, Turkey, The Netherlands, Greece and Switzerland.

The Print Design and Vintage Garments are together within the Atrium Hall and offers a selection of prints vintage which inspire the future collections.
